



## PARKING OPTIONS

Parking for the Tampa Bay History Center and Columbia Cafe is available at several private and city-owned lots in the Channelside District. Please note that the History Center does not own a parking lot or garage.

**Rates at the parking locations below are subject to change based on local events and availability.**

- The **Garrison Surface Lot** is available just to the west of Sparkman Wharf on the corner of Channelside Drive and Garrison Street. Parking is \$2.00 per hour or \$15.00 per day. Rates increase during special events. Reserve space upon arrival at a self-pay station. Payment is accepted using cash or credit/debit cards.
- The **Channelside Parking Garage**, located at 801 Channelside Drive, is directly across from the Sparkman Wharf shopping and entertainment complex and a short walk from the History Center. The fee for the Channelside garage is \$1.00 per ½ hour (\$15 max). When entering the garage, you will be given a token that is then inserted into a self-pay machine when returning to your car. Payment is accepted using cash or credit/debit cards.
- The **Pam Iorio Parking Garage** is adjacent to the Embassy Suites Hotel at 301 Channelside Drive, the JW Marriot Hotel at 510 Water Street, and just half a block north of the Marriott Water Street. This city-owned garage is a short walk from the History Center. The rate is usually \$1.60 hr/\$9.50 max but is subject to increase during special events. Payment is accepted using cash or credit/debit cards.
- Parking is also available in Ybor City. When parking at the garage on 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Nuccio Parkway, you can utilize the **TECO Line Streetcar** for transportation to the History Center. Exit at the HSBC Station (stop 9) and head east toward the History Center building.

- **Pirate Water Taxi** – Stop number 3- right behind the Tampa Bay History Center where you enter the Columbia Café - All day pass - \$20.00 adult and \$10.00 Child or After 6pm rate - \$15.00 adult and \$5.00 child. The 34- to 46-passenger Pirate Water Taxi stops five days a week at fixed locations along the Tampa Riverwalk, Davis Islands and Harbour Island. You can call (813) 390-3711 for a pick-up; some stops require a reservation. Please check Pirate Water Taxi website for updated schedules. - **TECO Line Streetcar- Free** - Stop number 8 right in front of the History Center runs every 20 minutes, except Friday and Saturday runs every 30 minutes. [www.tecolinestreetcar.org](http://www.tecolinestreetcar.org)
